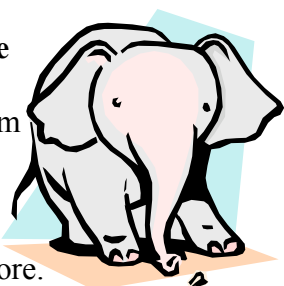
You are invited to **Welcome our New Minister**

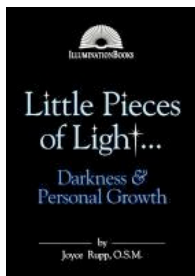

How to Stay Safe in the World Today

- Ⓢ Avoid riding in automobiles because they are responsible for 20% of all fatal accidents.
- Ⓢ Do not stay home because 17% of all accidents occur in the home.
- Ⓢ Avoid walking on streets or sidewalks because 14% of all accidents occur to pedestrians.
- Ⓢ Avoid traveling by air, rail, or water because 16% of all accidents involve these forms of transportation.
- Ⓢ Of the remaining 33%, 32% of all deaths occur in Hospitals.
- Ⓢ So, above all else, avoid hospitals.
