The 42nd General Council of the United Church of Canada put forth a plan to reorganize its structure, so that it could stay current with changing needs in the church network. After discussion with congregational members and addressing the concerns and questions raised, the Valois United Church Guidance Board submitted its vote of YES to Remits 1, 2 and 3, and NO on Remit 4 in June. In February 2018 Remit #6 is due and the congregation will be consulted again in November 2017.
